

Please be a good trail user and don't ride when the trails are closed due to poor conditions. You can call (408) 355-2200 (& press 4) before you leave home to avoid a wasted journey.

If you head over to Henry

Coe S.P., which never closes, the voluntary wet weather trail code there is to stay on the wide ranch roads and avoid the single track trails, for 48 hours after rain

I was out in Harvey Bear today and one rogue steer on the single track Calveras trail, through the woods on the east side, managed to make a right mess of things. But when the whole herd joined them it was a bumpy ride with nowhere to go. OK I was on a bicycle and too much air in the tires. – Tim Alton
