### Karen Mansel

Lifelong horsewoman Karen Mansel, passed away on December 6, 2023. She was one of the first members of SMHA and during her tenure serving two terms as Club President, membership soared to over 450 members.

She organized many overnight Horse camping trips to the Coast and High Sierras, which became annual Club traditions. The SMHA Color Guard was founded and performed with great success at several parades and a second place win at the Cow Palace. Fun events like Scavenger Hunt trail rides, Team Penning, Quadrille and the Galloping Goblin Poker Ride which is still an annual event for SMHA. The yearly Christmas potluck was enlivened with a program of zany skits Karen orchestrated.

Her passion for Trails led her to join both the County Mounted Assistance Unit at Mt. Madonna and the Henry Coe Park Mounted Assistance Unit. She earned her 2500 hour pin helping to scout, build, document and maintain the Coe Park trails.

Karen was active in NATRC Competitive Trail riding from 1972 through 1990, as both a competitor and volunteer. With over 2500 miles ridden in NATRC competitions on her beloved Drifter (JaDrift), the duo brought home many regional and national awards.

She and husband Jim retired to Georgetown, CA in 2006 where they remained active in church, volunteer work, and with their family of 8 grandchildren and 13 great-grandchildren.

A memorial camp scholarship fund has been established in her memory, for children to attend Forward Bible Camp (forwardbiblecamp.com).
